UP IN SMOKE \$10

Kirk & Sweeny 12 year dark rum floating atop ginger beer. Popular in sailing culture, this fruitless tropical rum drink is refreshing in any weather.

**Hotel Del Monte experienced a devastating fire in 1924 and was eventually rebuilt to its current status today*

THE CHILDREN'S PLAYROOM \$10

A timeless cocktail made with Hendricks Gin accented with lemon juice. Served up and topped with Wycliff sparkling.

**The room which is now the Trident Room was referred to as "the Children's Playroom" during the prohibition era.*

CROWN JEWEL \$10

For when you feel like mixing a good blended scotch. Rather than masking the flavor, Disaronno enhances the smokiness of JW Red label. Served on the rocks.

**Hotel Del Monte was the crown jewel in Crocker's 7,000 acre resort with a 125 acre botanical garden surrounding the hotel.*

17 MILE DRIVER \$10

Our fruity spin on a classic cocktail with a citrus finish. Featuring Ketel One vodka, served up.

**Hotel Del Monte was the original starting point for the 17 Mile Drive currently a huge tourist attraction for Pebble Beach in Carmel.*

THE 1942 \$10

A light sweet and sour citrus flavor profile showcases the essence of Bombay Sapphire gin. Served on the rocks.

**The hotel was taken over by the U.S Navy and used as a pre-flight school for aviators during WWII*

BEER COCKTAILS

EL MONTE APEROL MIST \$10

This sunset colored cocktail combines Aperol, lemon juice, and a Belgian style beer. Enjoy one in the Trident Rose Garden.

**The original owners knew that the name "Hotel del Monte" could not be changed without changing the Spanish meaning of the name. They decided to engrave "El Monte" meaning The Forest on table service but Hotel of the Forest is the full name in translation.*

THE AMERICAN TRAGEDY \$10

A California IPA with the bitter edge of gin and the tart punch of grapefruit. Enjoy the floral finish added from a light splash of St. Germaine

**When Hotel del Monte opened after prohibition, a similar drink was coined by Theodore Dreiser*

SNAKEBITE \$10

With origins in the UK, this mixture creates a light and easy to drink beverage. Fermented fruit of our local Golden State cider compliments the bitter fermented grain of Guinness. A drink for anytime of the year.
